

Tricks for Better Process Paragraphs

Here are some things you should do when you write Process Paragraphs.

Titling

- How to _____
- _____ing _____

Example:

- How to Bake Healthy Bread
- Baking Your Own Amazing Bread

Include a positive adjective!

(the verb phrase is important here!)

In Your Topic Sentence

- **Mentioning the Topic** (the Process you're explaining)
- **Encouraging the reader** to feel they *can* and *should* do the process: "I can do this! It's easy!" & "I want to try this!"
- **Signaling that a process will be explained in the paragraph**, usually through a step-by-step explanation.
 - ... if you follow a few simple steps.
 - ... if you use the following process.

Example:

1. It's very easy and fun to make your own delicious and healthy bread at home in a bread machine if you follow this simple process.
2. When you'd like to change a tire on your car by yourself, it's easy if you just follow a few simple steps.

In the Concluding Sentence

- **Mentioning the outcome of the process:** when you finish the process, what is the expected result.

- **Making a delicious cast iron pan pizza is easy and fun**, if you follow these a few basic steps.
- It's easy and fun to make a delicious cast iron pan pizza using the following few steps.
- Anyone can easily make an outstanding cast iron pan pizza if they follow a few basic steps.
